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Handling and Care Instruction for your Mirror

Read Carefully
Important

- The best and safest cleaner for a mirror is clean, warm water used with a soft, clean cloth. Be careful not to allow the edges of the mirror to get or remain wet over a period of time.
- Do not use any acid or alkali cleaners for mirror cleanup after installation. They can attack the surface and edges as well as the backing of the mirror. And never use an abrasive cleaner on any mirror surface.
- You may also use a standard brand of glass or mirror cleaner that does not contain ammonia or vinegar.
- Remove surface marks or stubborn dirt with 0000 oil-free steel wool, not solvents. These could attack and damage the edges and backing.
- Never spray any cleaner directly onto a mirror. Instead, apply the cleaner to a soft cloth and then wipe the mirror.
- Always use a soft, clean, grit free cloth when cleaning a mirror to reduce scratching the surface.
- Be sure to dry all joint and edges to be certain no commercial cleaner comes in contact with the edge or backing.

Note: Good ventilation will keep mirror from "sweating" and creating condensing liquids which could be corrosive and damaging to mirrors.
